HER STORY

Her abuser broke into her home and shot her in the arm while her kids were sleeping. Because she recovered in the hospital instead of working, her water and electricity were shut off for non-payment. YOUR donations gave this traumatized family the financial relief of running water and electricity as they heal.

A YEAR OF NEW CONNECTIONS

Many vulnerable families who are eligible to receive food stamps have no idea how to receive them. This year, we advocated for 51 families receive SNAP benefits so they can receive additional food support as well as our food drives.

A NETWORK OF SERVING

We know when we work together, we can reach more people for Christ. We distributed 1,557 pallets of goods to 87 different churches, schools, and nonprofits to serve 60,925 at-risk families in Arkansas.

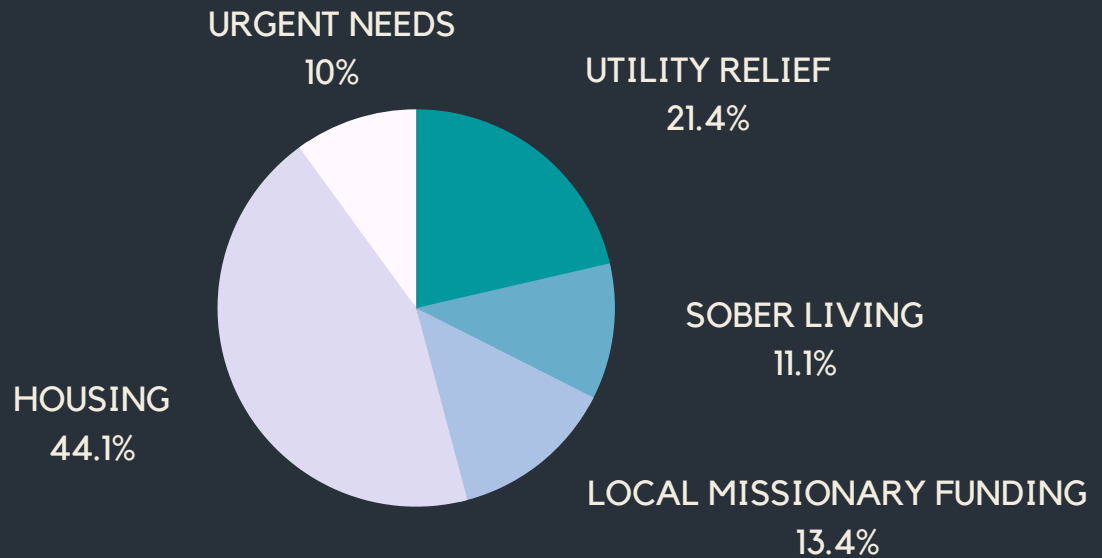
